Thank you for your interest in the West Virginia House of Delegates Page Program where students serve as honorary pages for a day during the legislative session. The sixty-day session begins Wednesday, February 13, 2013 and concludes on the final night of Saturday, April 13, 2013.

Students from all over the state apply for the Page Program so contact your Delegate for sponsorship, as participation is limited. Please visit the West Virginia Legislature Website at <http://www.legis.state.wv.us/> where you will find information about the Page Program and a Citizen's Guide to the Capitol under the Educational Tab. In addition, your Delegate's biographical information, phone number and Capitol address is located under House Tab: Members. The Charleston Convention and Visitors website: www.charlestonwv.com is a good source for hotel accommodations, dining, and entertainment while in Charleston.

- **Arrival and etiquette:** Pages will meet on the second floor of the Capitol near the rotunda at 10 a.m., just in front of the House Chamber for orientation and Chamber etiquette briefing. **Chaperones are requested to remain with your Pages during the floor session. Chaperones are not permitted on the House floor, but are invited to view the activities from one of the three House galleries.** Please be aware the length of the session for the day is determined by the House's agenda. Floor sessions tend to be briefer during the early weeks, and lengthen in duration as the session progresses. Sessions may last thirty minutes to more than an hour and a half and the House may reconvene later in the day. Pages remain in the Chamber at the end of session for photographs with your sponsoring Delegate and a certificate of appreciation. Chaperones please meet your pages in the Chambers.
- **Road Conditions:** Check out Road Conditions at www.transportation.wv.gov.
- **Parking/Lunch:** (Please refer to the website under the Educational tab; Citizens Guide for more information). Free parking is available for students and chaperones at Laidley Field on the lot adjacent to the football field. A courtesy shuttle provided by "KRT" runs every ten minutes to the Capitol. Your stop is at the East Wing of the main Capitol building. You are welcome to enjoy lunch after the session. The Capitol Complex Food Court is open in the lower level. Cost: from \$5.00 to \$10.00 per person.
- **Appropriate Dress:** Please be respectful of appropriate dress guidelines. Professional attire along with comfortable footwear is recommended. It is important that the dress code of the House be upheld; therefore, **t-shirts, jeans, short skirts, bare midriffs, tank tops, sandals and sneakers are not permitted inside the chamber during daily floor sessions.**

Students will receive confirmation by email once scheduled. Attached is the Page Request Form and State Capitol Tour information.
