Thank you for your interest in the West Virginia House of Delegates Page Program. Since 1993, the Page Program has become a regular part of the House services to its Members and the public. It has also provided a wonderful communication link between Delegates and students. Our goal is to provide an educational experience to students participating as Pages during the Regular Session of the Legislature.

The West Virginia Legislature will convene for the 2014 Regular Session on Wednesday, January 8, and conclude on Saturday, March 8. For an individual to be considered for the program, an application must be completed and returned for review. Participants must be in grades 6 through 12, from West Virginia's public or non public schools and sponsored by a Delegate. The Program allows up to 20 participants per day, Monday-Friday. Participants will be given the first available date that is listed on their application. **Chaperones are required to be in one of the three House galleries while the individual is participating in the program.**

The West Virginia Legislature's website is an excellent resource. You can find contact information for your Delegate along with information about the Back to School Program, Citizen's Guide to the Capitol, Page Program and Streaming Audio of daily floor session. Once approved, participants will receive an email with a confirmation notice and additional program information.
